


Welcome

The Vision and Strategy build on the success over the last few years. They were developed following extensive consultation with governors, staff, students, parents, parishes and neighbouring schools.



Our school priorities are....

Strategic Priority 1- Ethos

Provide an inclusive Christ-centred education at Oaklands based on the mission of the Catholic Church.

To accomplish this we will:

- Actively develop a school that fosters faith formation rooted in Catholic values.
- Value the individual whilst recognising the need for young people to develop the skills necessary to be successful as adults, parents and members of society.
- Maintain a significant commitment to support the poor and marginalised within our community to ensure that aspirations are raised and opportunities equalised.
- Reach out to those who actively desire access to a Catholic education at Oaklands for their children.
- Provide opportunities for the community to demonstrate its faith through charitable activities both in action and word.
- Remain faithful to our Catholic mission whilst being cognisant of external challenges and opportunities.

Strategic Priority 2 - Teaching and Learning

Oaklands will be recognised for setting the highest standards of teaching and learning, where aspirations and achievements are raised for all so that no one is left behind.

To accomplish this we will:

- Sustain innovative and stimulating teaching and learning strategies that will challenge Oaklands students' expectations.

- Monitor outcomes for all to ensure that no one gets left behind and intervene quickly when necessary.

Strategic Priority 3 - Collaboration

- Maximise opportunities that come from working closely with businesses, industries and our Alumni outside the educational sector.
- Collaborate with local schools and colleges to improve the life-chances of young people within the SE Hants area.

Strategic Priority 5 - Students
