

Reflexive verbs

- Reflexive verbs have a reflexive pronoun between the subject and the verb, which we don't use in English. This pronoun is used with verbs that you can do to your self.

E.g Je me lave

Verb table

Se laver

Je me lave

Tu te laves

Il/elle se lave

Nous nous lavons

Vous vous lavez

Ils/elles se lavent

To get washed

I get washed

You get washed

He/she gets washed

We get washed

You get washed

They get washed

Other reflexive verbs

Je m'appelle – I am called (I call myself)

Je m'habille – I get (myself) dressed

Je me couche – I go to bed (I put myself to bed).

Je me lève – I get (myself) up

Je me lave – I get (myself) washed

Je me repose – I rest (myself).

Making a reflexive verb

I get up at six o'clock

Verb – Se lever – to get up.

Add subject = Je

Add pronoun = me

Add conjugated verb from table = lève

Phrase = Je me lève à six heures.
