The Present Tense

- Used to describe events that happen in the present or that happen regularly/usually
- Eg. I play, I go

How to form the present tense

- 1. Take the infinitive (the verb in its unchanged form, found in the dictionary, in Spanish it ends in either -ar, -er, -ir)
- 2. Remove the *ar/er/ir*
- 3. Add the appropriate endings

	HABL AR	COMER	VIVIR
	To speak	To eat	To live
I (yo)	Habl o	Como	Vivo
You (tu)	Habl as	Comes	Vives
He/she/it (el/ella)	Habl a	Come	Vive
We (nosotros)	Habl amos	Comemos	Viv imos
You (vosotros)	Habl áis	Com éis	Viv ís
They (ellos/ellas)	Habl an	Comen	Viven

• Remember the subject (*yo, tu el, ella...*) is not expressed in Spanish, it is shown only in the verb ending. Eg. *I eat = como*

EXAMPLES
