# What is Unifrog?

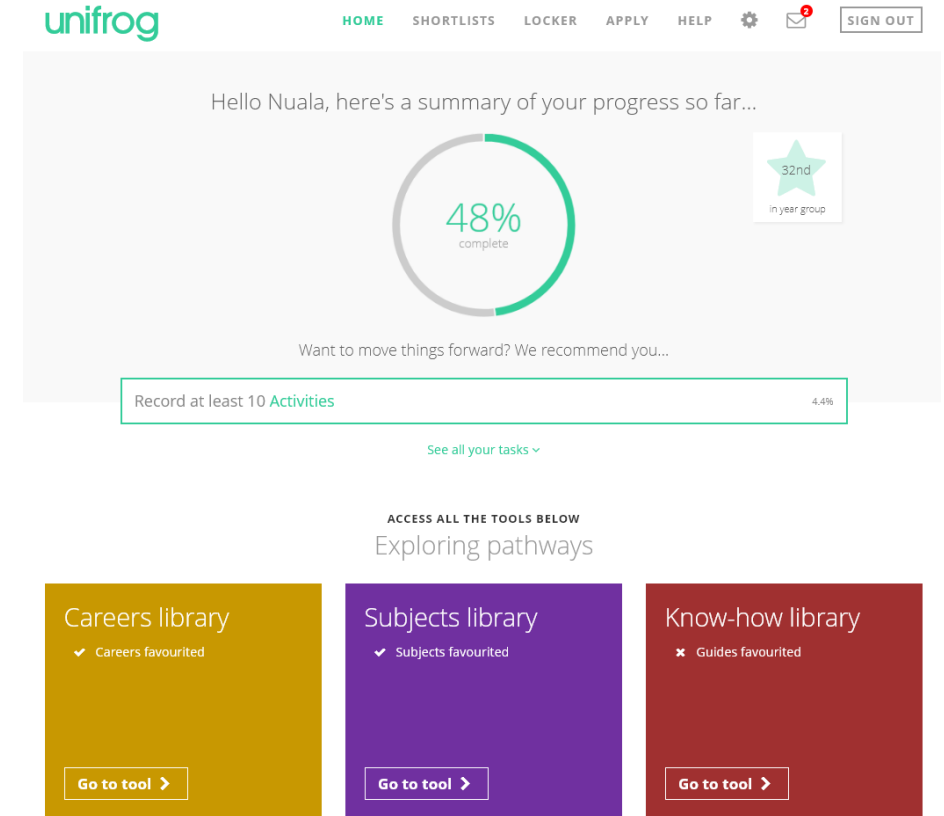
Unifrog is a one-stop-shop where students can easily explore their interests, then find and successfully apply for their next best step after school.

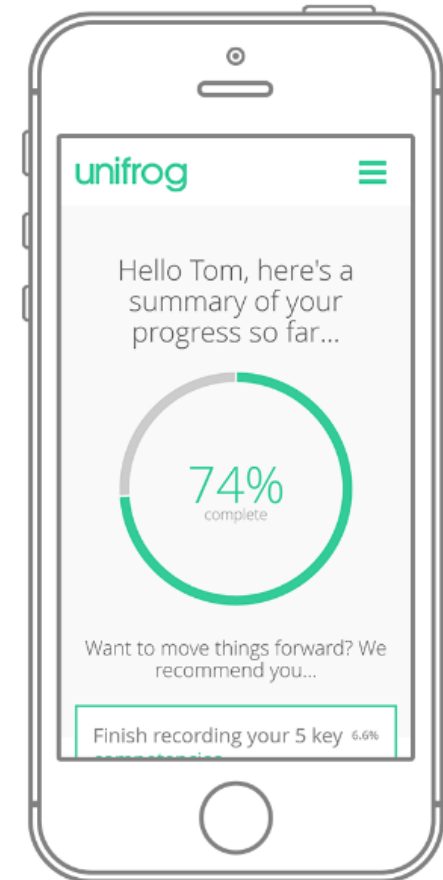
