Linear GCSE Exams Grade 9-1

- 2 Cohorts of 5 sets (Same as year 9)
 - ALL Pupils will sit either Higher or Foundation tier.
 - Both tiers are made up of 3 papers. 2 Calculator and 1 Non- Calculator Paper
 - All three exams are 1 hour 30 minutes
 - Gold standard is grade 5.
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- Only after the January mocks in year 11 will the paper (Higher or Foundation) be decided

Further Maths (FSMQ)

- Top set pupils will be taught the Linear Maths in year 10 and 11
- Further Maths will be available to the most able as an extra GCSE through an after school lesson each week in year 11.

This means a possibility of 2 Maths qualifications at the end of year 11.

- Linear GCSE Maths

The 3 exams will be sat at the end of year 11

- Further Maths

Pupils will be taught the FSMQ syllabus – extension of linear and closes gap to A Level

There are 2 exams 1 hour 30 each
