AlloTalk Chat Room App – for your awareness...

Allotalk is an online chat room app with no registration requirement or age verification, similar to Omegle, allowing users to be anonymous. Aimed at 13-19yr olds, AlloTalk makes it possible to chat with strangers and in private, advertising with the words: 'Join us now and talk to random strangers and people from all over the world'.

It describes itself as having the best features for users, highlighting that they can join different public chat rooms and group chats including stranger chat, teen chat, dating chat, roleplay, adult, gay, lesbian and international chat room - also that users can make their own chat room with full control over it.

Although not yet included on the NSPCC or Net-Aware sites, Allotalk has raised concerns locally. It presents worryingly similar risks as Omegle, possibly more so being as this is aimed at 13-19yr olds with focus on 'flirting' and 'dating' and draws attention to specific protected characteristics which may attract predators and increase exploitation by adults.
