Use of face coverings in school



Since the start of term we have recommended that all members of our community wear face coverings in communal areas. Some of you have chosen to do this but many have not.

We have now been given the following guidance from the Department for Education..

'face coverings should be worn by adults and children aged 11 and

above when moving around the preactivity rooms, such as in corridors distancing cannot easily be maintain

This guidance was released late Wednesday and came into effect Thursday 5.11.2020. As a school we will be enforcing this from Monday (as we would any uniform regulation) but if you have a covering in school with you today please do wear it as directed.

What does this mean for us?



ALL members of the community (students and staff) MUST wear a face covering when..

- Walking into school and in muster areas in the morning
- When walking to and from lessons
- In the canteen and corridors
- When leaving the school site at the end of the day
- ANYTIME where social distancing cannot be easily maintained / when bubbles mix

The only time it is not mandatory for you to wear a face covering is when you are in lessons sat facing forward.

How to wear a face covering correctly

Wash your hands for 20 seconds or sanitise before putting your face covering on

Ensure the covering is covering your nose and mouth

Do not touch your face / eyes

Wash or sanitise your hands before taking the covering off


When you take the covering off store it i
