## **COVID-19 Lateral flow Tests and Vaccinations**

You might have seen that there has been a lot in the media about the much-mooted plans for 12+ vaccines, this follows the successful trials of the Pfizer/BioNTech vaccine. Approval in the UK has been given by the medicines regulator for children aged 12-15. What happens next will, I suspect, be based on decisions made in Whitehall.

Please can I remind all parents and students to continue to engage with the twice weekly lateral flow tests and report the results through the Test Register App. The LFT process is one of the key control measures we have to ensure we keep our school community as safe as we can as lockdown eases and we are keen to minimise the numbers of students needing to isolate this half term.

#### **Holiday Activities Programme**
