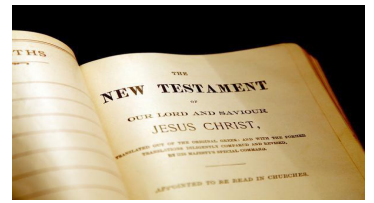

What we are thinking about:

- ✓ Who was Jesus, according to the Gospel writers? Who did the people think he was? Was he the Messiah? Did some Jews feel let down by Jesus and if so, why? What were they hoping for instead?
- ✓ Who did Jesus come into conflict with and why? Was there a plot to kill him? Why?
- ✓ Why did he have to die when he did? (link to Passover, themes of sacrifice and atonement)
- ✓ Did Jesus know what He was saying 'yes' to when He accepted his mission from God – did He die because He freely chose His destiny?
- ✓ Why did his death have to be public? Why could he not just have died of old age?
- ✓ What theological (religious reasons) were there for his death? Link to the fulfilment of scripture and the prophecies in the Old Testament
- ✓ Think about the **Resurrection** and how it makes sense of Jesus' death.

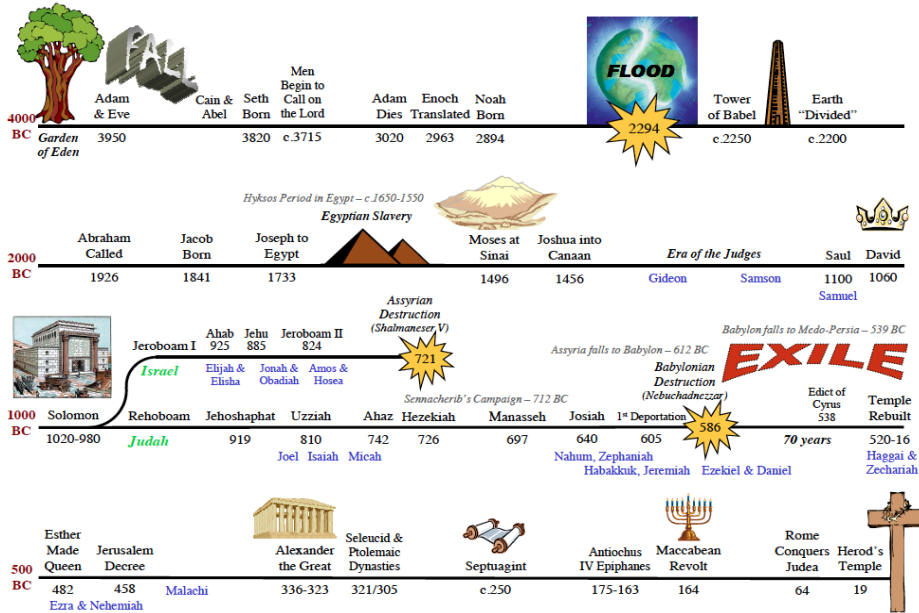

Write a paragraph (12-15 lines) outlining what hopes the Jews had for their Messiah at the time of Jesus and how He did– and did not - meet these expectations.

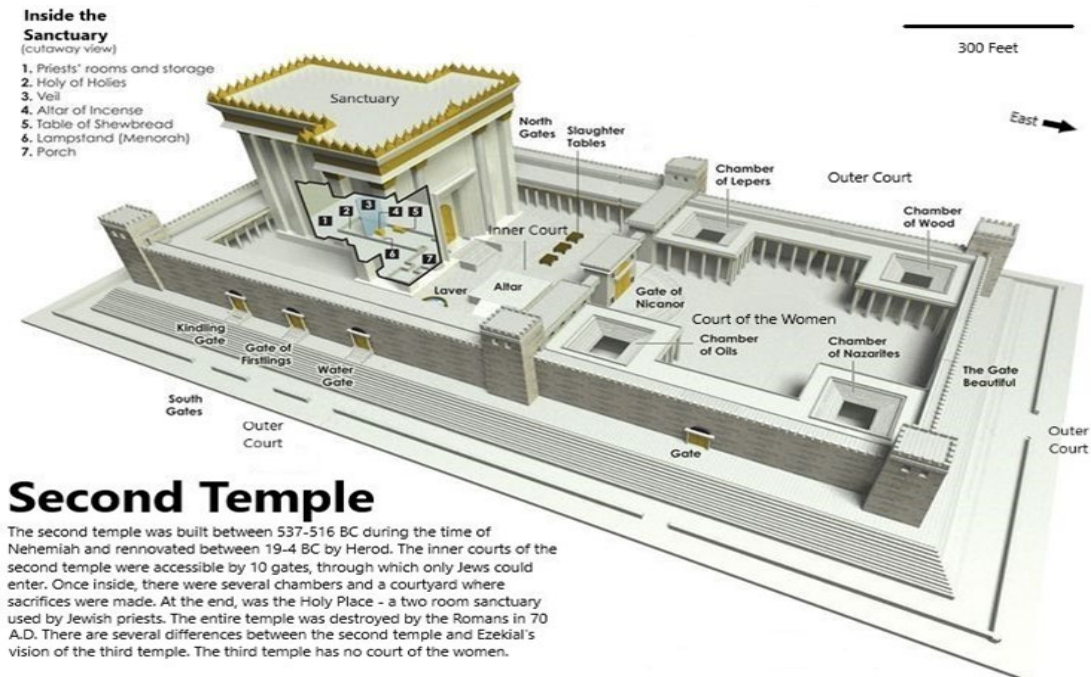

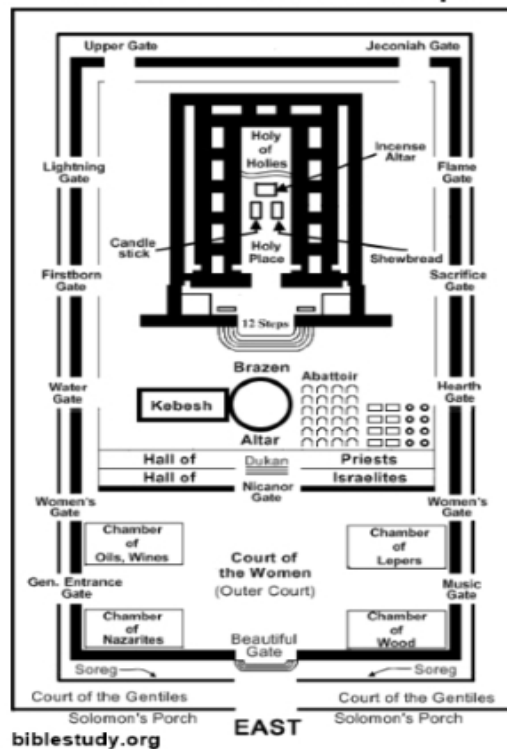
