Dear Parents and Carers

As you will all no doubt be aware, with the emergence of the Omicron variant of COVID-19, some safety measures have been reintroduced taking effect from last Tuesday (30 November), for example, the mandatory wearing of face coverings in shops and on public transport (with the exception of those who are exempt).

From a school perspective, the guidance states 'face coverings should be worn in communal areas in all settings by staff, visitors and pupils in Year 7 and above unless they are exempt'. The latest guidance confirms face coverings are not necessary outside.

The practice of the wearing of face coverings in communal areas such as corridors, stairways and the dining hall has been continued by some students throughout the pandemic. Of course, anyone who feels safer wearing a face covering in classrooms will be fully supported in doing so, though at present this is not part of the DfE guidance.

If your child is exempt from wearing a face covering, please inform Mrs Bonnington, Deputy Head, if you haven't already, and we can update our records.

Please may I also remind those of you whose children travel to school by bus that they need to wear a face covering to travel, unless they are exempt. Bus companies may refuse passengers if they are not wearing a face covering (unless exempt).

The situation regarding the Omicron variant is constantly evolving. If further updates to DfE guidance occur in forthcoming days and weeks, I will be in touch regarding the implications for us.

Thank you all so much for the way in which you have cooperated with us throughout the pandemic. The most recent guidance does state that staff and students should continue with twice weekly LFD testing, and we would ask for your continued support with this. No doubt you will also be aware that all students need to be tested in school at the start of next term. This will necessitate a phased start. I will write to you again next week providing the details related to the in-school testing in January.

End of Term Events

At the time of writing, we are continuing to plan our Christmas season events. We sincerely hope that all of these will go ahead. Our students have been so resilient and mature in the face of so many challenges and changes and we are incredibly proud of them. Hopefully, we can progress towards Christmas safely and have a well-earned and happy festive period.
