VALUES	PROGRESS	AN EXAMPLE
Democracy		Rights in HSC in Unit 2 e.g. choice, consultation.
Rule of Law		Legislation in HSC Unit 2 and Unit 3 such as The Equality Act and divorce laws in Sociology.
Individual Liberty		Independent learning & flipped learning tasks in all subjects. Choice in group projects.
Mutual Respect		Class discussions where students must respect opinions of others.
Respect for those of different faiths and beliefs		In HSC Unit 2 cultural diversity in different care settings. Culture and family unit in Sociology explore different aspects of cultural identity and beliefs.
Faith		End of day prayer Religious diversity explored in Sociology culture unit.
Hope		Treatments for particular conditions are described and evaluated in HSC.

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VIRTUES	PROGRESS	AN EXAMPLE
Love and Charity		Department contributes to whole school charity events such as St Johns. Encourage students love and curiosity of subjects within department.
Temperance		Coursework in Health & Social Care is demanding and requires self reliance and independence.
Justice		Inequality unit in Sociology explores how difficult social groups are disadvantaged. In HSC students identify poor standards of care in care settings and a range of consequences.
Solidarity		Students are encourage to work collaboratively during group work such as the Sociology crime research task.
Wonder		Theories within Psychology promote curiosity such as Freud. Not all topics encourage wonder from the students.
Courage		Students are encouraged to persevere with difficult tasks. Groups who have shown courage such as the Suffragettes and the civil rights movement have been used to represent social change in Psychology.
