Dear Parent/Carer,

Year 9 and Sixth Form Ski Trip to Andalo, Italy – February 2023

For over thirty years we have organised skiing trips for Year 9 and Sixth Form students; these have proved to be very popular. We are now planning a similar event for February 2023 after a two-year break due to the pandemic. We will be going to the Hotel Costa Verde in Andalo for the seventh time. A video taken from a previous visit is on the school YouTube channel - <u>https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=Ldyyou7w0x4</u>.

The trip will take place mainly during the half-term holiday, travelling on Friday 10th February (normally leaving school about 2.00pm) and returning on Saturday 18th February 2023 (likely to be approximately 9.00am).

There are definitely **82 places** on offer for this trip. 40 of the places will be allocated for the Sixth Form (current Y11 and 12 students) and the remaining 42 will be for Year 9 (current Y8) students, but places will be filled by either year group if a particular year group doesn't fill their allocation by the closing date. If numbers are low, we may open it to current Y9 students too. The trip is not on a first come, first served basis. The first 82 student names drawn after the closing date will be those who will secure a place. We will continue to draw the remaining names to provide us with a waiting list, should this be needed. The ski company have said that we <u>could</u> expand the trip to a maximum of 106, but this would require a third coach (82 = 2 coaches). Therefore, if we get 106 replies then the students will go. If we get anywhere between 83 and 105, then I will have to contact the company to see if they allow us to go, as we may not reach the number required to make a third coach financially viable.

What does the price include?

Included in the cost, which is **<u>£1027</u>**

- Coach travel and Channel Tunnel/ Ferry crossing
- Hoody
- 6 nights full board accommodation Hotel Costa Verde, Andalo -<u>http://www.hotelcostaverde.it/index.php/it/</u>
- Hot lunches are provided in a restaurant on the mountain students can choose what they want (e.g. pizza, chips and a soft drink) and are provided with a voucher each day. Breakfast in the hotel is buffet style; evening meals are three courses and tend to be traditional Italian food.
- 4 hours (days 1 and 2) or 5 hours (days 3, 4 and 5) ski lessons each day and a 5 day lift pass <u>students will</u> <u>only ski under supervision</u>. Qualified ski instructors from the resort deliver all tuition. Students are likely to be in groups of 10-12 and I will allocate a member of Oaklands staff to also ski with that group to help deal with any issues.
- All ski equipment hire (skis, boots, poles and helmet)
- Some evening entertainment (swimming at the local pool, quiz night etc.)

Other Potential Costs

There are a number of other costs that I would like to make you aware of:

- Pre-skiing course at Calshot (for beginners normally the last week of term in December), approximately £30.
- Ski clothing i.e. salopettes/ski trousers, jacket, goggles, socks, gloves and under layers cheap options can be found at places such as Sports Direct. Lidl often sells cheap ski clothing around Christmas. In fact, I purchased ski trousers from there for £20 and my wife purchased a ski coat for £25; both are excellent.
- Drinks and meals on the journey we stop at service stations and will visit a supermarket the day before our return journey to allow students to stock up. Students will need a packed lunch for the day of departure, money for an evening meal on the ferry, breakfast and some lunch for the following day. We will leave immediately after breakfast on the day of return, so students will need money for lunch, an evening meal and breakfast the following day.
- Tourist tax I have budgeted for this based on the prices last paid in February 2019. I doubt it will change a great deal, but if it does I will have to pass this on to parents (it was 2 Euro per night last time).

Covid issues

- As we use a coach to get to Italy, we will be travelling through France, Belgium, Germany, Austria and Italy (we have even been through Switzerland in previous visits too). Each country has their own approach in terms of Covid rules, which could change at any time between now and February 2023. Essentially, if your child is not fully vaccinated, they run the risk that they will not be able to go please consider this very carefully when committing to the trip. Insurance would not cover someone who can't go due to not being vaccinated, as this would be deemed to be disinclination to travel.
- £22 of the cost of the trip is the insurance provided by the ski company (we normally just travel with the Hampshire County Council educational trips policy). I have opted for this additional coverage for the 2023 trip to give us the best chance of being covered if there are Covid issues. I have included the policy documents on the school ski trip webpage - <u>Ski Trip - Oaklands Catholic School and Sixth Form College</u> should you wish to read them.

Finance Arrangements

- A deposit of £100 for students is due by Monday 14th February 2022 (once you have been informed that your child has gained a place, following the ballot on Tuesday 8th February 2022 parents will be told by Wednesday 9th February whether their child has been successful in gaining a place).
- Second payment £200 by Friday 1st April 2022
- Third payment £100 by Tuesday 3th May 2022
- Fourth payment £150 by Monday 6th June 2022
- Fifth payment £150 by Monday 4th July 2022
- Sixth payment £150 by Monday 5th September 2022
- Seventh and final payment £177 by Monday 3rd October 2022.

Our preferred method of payment is online. Alternatively, you can pay by cash or cheque (made payable to Oaklands Catholic School). The £100 deposit is non-returnable. We will transfer this money to the ski company on Friday 18th February 2022. Similarly, we have to pay £200 per person to the company in April and another £100 per person in May – these are also non-refundable once paid. From that point, we only have to pay a final balance to the ski company in mid-November. If you drop out, and it is not for an insurable reason, after that point then we would not be able to refund any payments, unless we were able to find a replacement. Essentially, please don't put your name forward for the trip if you think there is a chance that your child might drop out.

Please note if you are a current Year 11 or 12 student your inclusion is conditional upon you being a member of Oaklands Sixth Form College at the time of the ski trip. Deposits are non-returnable if you withdraw because you are not a member of our college. Therefore, do not apply unless you are absolutely committed to returning in September to the Sixth Form.

As this trip is non-curricular the school is normally unable to offer financial assistance and therefore the full cost of the activity must be borne by yourselves. Payments and accompanying paperwork must be handed in on or before the deadline dates outlined above and late payments will jeopardise your child's place on the trip. If there are any significant changes to the cost of the trip these may have to be passed on to the students. Be assured that we will try to keep such increases to a minimum.

Please complete and return the consent form to the <u>Finance Office</u>. THE CLOSING DATE FOR INITIAL RETURNS WILL BE 3:30pm ON <u>TUESDAY 8TH FEBRUARY 2022</u>. The draw to allocate places will be made after school on that day and you will be informed whether your child has secured a place by Wednesday 9th February; payment of the first deposit will then be due by Monday 14th February 2022.

Please be aware that your child's place will be lost if payment is not received by the deadline.
