

Dear Parents

MUSIC TUITION - 2022/2023

Students can elect to be taught either individually or within a group ranging from 2 to 4 students, provided the peripatetic staff can accommodate for your chosen instrument.

The number of lessons provided across the academic year will be 32 and the fees will still represent outstanding value at £16.87 per session for an individual lesson and only £8.34 per session for a group lesson. This equates to the following termly charges:-

Individual £180.00 per term £89.00 per term

Despite the significant rise in inflation currently the Governing Body is continuing to subsidise the cost of tuition and the level of subsidy and costs passed on to parents will continue to be reviewed annually. If, however, parents wish to benefit from the subsidy then they must realise that students will be strongly encouraged by the Governors to take part in extra-curricular activities e.g. Band, School Choir, Ensembles, Workshops, Concerts, etc.

Students who study A level Music/BTEC receive free music tuition for one instrument. If they wish to receive tuition for a second instrument then they will be charged at a rate of £89.00 per term for individual lessons.

Parents who are in receipt of Income Support are asked to write to me in the same way as they do for Educational Trips.

Instruments taught at present:

Strings violin, viola, cello

Brass trumpet, trombone, French horn, tenor horn, tuba, euphonium

Woodwind flute, clarinet, saxophone, recorder

Guitars classical, electric, bass Keyboard piano, electronic keyboard

Voice Drums





A small number of instruments may be borrowed for a short period of time. In particular, we are able to offer violin and brass instruments to borrow and we would like to encourage new students on these instruments to take advantage of this opportunity. Should there be an oversubscription to this we will draw a ballot. This is usually no longer than one term. Please contact Mrs S Richardson for availability.

It may be useful to know that instruments can be bought through the school, free of VAT using the Assisted Instrument Purchase Scheme (AIPS). This is a Government initiative designed to increase the number of students learning to play an instrument. There are certain conditions that have to be met to benefit from this initiative and if any parent wishes to take up this opportunity then they should email Mrs S Richardson for details.

Would you please carefully read, complete, sign and date the attached form; a separate form should be completed for each instrument. Please return the form(s) with payment to the Finance Office at the school. Please make cheques payable to Oaklands Catholic School or pay online using the School's online payment system. Please note that a half term's notice must be given if you wish to cancel tuition, please see point 7 in the application from. For students in Year 11 and 13, lessons will end at May half term, however arrangements can be made to continue tuition through until July.

If you have any queries Mrs S Richardson, Head of Performing Arts, or the Finance Office will be happy to offer advice and can be contacted via the main school telephone number. In any event, all completed forms should be returned to the school as soon as possible and no later than 29 July 2022.
