Dear Parent/Carer,

Year 9 and Sixth Form Ski Trip to Andalo, Italy – February 2025

For over thirty years we have organised skiing trips for Year 9 and Sixth Form students; these have proved to be very popular. We are now planning a similar event for February 2025 following a successful trip this February. We will be going to the Hotel Costa Verde in Andalo for the ninth time. The trip will take place during the half-term holiday, travelling on Saturday 15th February and returning on Saturday 22nd February 2025.

There are definitely **80 places** on offer for this trip. 40 of the places will be allocated for the Sixth Form (current Y11 and 12 students) and the remaining 40 will be for Year 9 (current Year 8) students, but places will be filled by either year group if a particular year group doesn't fill their allocation by the closing date. If numbers are low, we may open it to current Year 9 students too. The trip is not on a first come, first served basis. The first 80 student names drawn after the closing date will be those who will secure a place. We will continue to draw the remaining names to provide us with a waiting list, should this be needed. The ski company have said that we **could** expand the trip, but I will have to see what numbers express interest.

What does the price include?

Included in the cost, which is **£1341**:

- Coach travel and Channel Tunnel/ Ferry crossing
- Hoody
- 5 nights full board accommodation – Hotel Costa Verde, Andalo - <http://www.hotelcostaverde.it/index.php/it/>
- Hot lunches are provided in a restaurant on the mountain – students can choose what they want (e.g. pizza, chips and a soft drink) and are provided with a voucher each day. Breakfast in the hotel is buffet style; evening meals are three courses and tend to be traditional Italian food.
- 5 hours (days 1 to 4) or 3 hours (day 5) ski lessons each day and a 5 day lift pass – **students will only ski under supervision**. Qualified ski instructors from the resort deliver all tuition. Students are likely to be in groups of 10-12 and I will allocate a member of Oaklands staff to also ski with that group to help deal with any issues. On the final day we ski as normal in the morning, then return to the hotel to change and then leave to drive home.
- All ski equipment hire (skis, boots, poles and helmet) and insurance
- Some evening entertainment (swimming at the local pool, possible night skiing for those who have skied before etc.)

I normally get letters out a week or so earlier, but I have been trying to negotiate the price with the company, as it has gone up last year. Students, don't pester your parents, as this is a significant sum of money. Unfortunately, inflation and skiing in general is becoming more expensive.

Other Potential Costs

There are a number of other costs that I would like to make you aware of:

- Pre-skiing course at Calshot (for beginners – normally the last week of term in December), approximately £30.
- Ski clothing i.e. ski trousers, jacket, goggles, socks, gloves and under layers - cheap options can be found at places such as Sports Direct. Lidl often sells cheap ski clothing around Christmas.
- Drinks and meals on the journey – we stop at service stations and will visit a supermarket the day before our return journey to allow students to stock up. Students will need a packed lunch for the day of departure, money for an evening meal on the ferry, breakfast and some lunch for the following day. We will leave immediately after lunch on the day of return, so students will need money for an evening meal and breakfast the following day.
- Tourist tax – I have budgeted for this based on the prices last paid in February 2024. I doubt it will change a great deal, but if it does I will have to pass this on to parents (it was 2 Euro per night last time).

Covid issues

As we use a coach to get to Italy, we will be travelling through France, Belgium, Germany, Austria and Italy (we have even been through Switzerland in previous visits too). Each country has their own approach in terms of Covid rules, which could change at any time between now and February 2025. **Essentially, if your child is not fully vaccinated, they run the risk that they will not be able to go – please consider this very carefully when committing to the trip.** Insurance would not cover someone who can't go due to not being vaccinated, as this would be deemed to be disinclination to travel. However, I doubt restrictions will come back in given the time that has elapsed since they were last in place.

Fitness

Skiing is a strenuous activity, so please ensure that your child does the ski exercises we give them to ensure that they have the level of fitness required.

Passport & EHIC/GHIC cards

Students will need a passport and an in-date EHIC or GHIC card in order to travel.

Finance Arrangements

- A deposit of £101 for students is due by Wednesday 20th March 2024 (once you have been informed that your child has gained a place, following the ballot on Tuesday 19th March 2024 - parents will be told by Tuesday 19th March whether their child has been successful in gaining a place). **I CAN'T STRESS HIGHLY ENOUGH THE NEED TO PAY THE £101 DEPOSIT BY WEDNESDAY 20TH, AS THE BEDS ARE ON HOLD FOR US UNTIL THURSDAY 21ST; WE HAVE TO PAY THE COMPANY BY THAT DATE OR WE LOSE THE HOTEL ROOMS.**
- Second payment - £200 by Friday 26th April 2024
- Third payment - £100 by Tuesday 24th May 2024
- Fourth payment - £235 by Friday 28th June 2024
- Fifth payment - £235 by Thursday 18th July 2024
- Sixth payment - £235 by Monday 6th September 2024
- Seventh and final payment - £235 by Monday 4th October 2024.

Our preferred method of payment is online. Alternatively, you can pay by cash or cheque (made payable to Oaklands Catholic School). The £101 deposit is non-returnable. We will transfer this money to the ski company on Thursday 21st March 2024. Similarly, we have to pay £200 per person to the company in April and another £100 per person in May – these are also non-refundable once paid. From that point, we only have to pay a final balance to the ski company in mid-November. If you drop out, and it is not for an insurable reason, after that point then we would not be able to refund any payments, unless we were able to find a replacement.

Essentially, please don't put your name forward for the trip if you think there is a chance that your child might drop out.


Please note if you are a current Year 11 or 12 student your inclusion is conditional upon you being a member of Oaklands Sixth Form College at the time of the ski trip. Deposits are non-returnable if you withdraw because you are not a member of our college. Therefore, do not apply unless you are absolutely committed to returning in September to the Sixth Form.

As this trip is non-curricular the school is normally unable to offer financial assistance and therefore the full cost of the activity must be borne by yourselves. Payments and accompanying paperwork must be handed in on or before the deadline dates outlined above and late payments will jeopardise your child's place on the trip. If there are any significant changes to the cost of the trip these may have to be passed on to the students. Be assured that we will try to keep such increases to a minimum.

Please complete and return the consent form below to the **Finance Office**. THE CLOSING DATE FOR INITIAL RETURNS WILL BE 11:50am ON **TUESDAY 19TH MARCH 2024**. The draw to allocate places will be made on that day and you will be informed whether your child has secured a place by the evening of the 19th (monitor ClassCharts announcements and students check your Team); payment of the first deposit will then be due by **WEDNESDAY 20th MARCH 2024**.

Please be aware that your child's place could be lost if payment is not received by the deadline.
