## PE – Wearing PE kit to school

Dear Parents/Guardians,

You will have read in the Oaklands News that the school is undertaking a heating replacement project, the next phase of this will have an impact on PE lessons.

Due to the work being carried out, some of the changing rooms will be inaccessible from **Thursday 10<sup>th</sup> October until the end of term**. As a result, we are allowing students who normally change in the Sports hall changing rooms to wear their PE kit to school. This will help ensure that students can continue to participate in their lessons without disruption. Arrangements will be made so students bags and other belongings can be kept securely.

Your child will be able to check the class code against their timetable on class charts to confirm if the temporary arrangement impacts their lesson. Form Tutors will also remind students.

**Students not included in this list are expected to wear full school uniform as normal on days they have PE.** Additionally, students who are participating in Rugby will continue with their lessons as scheduled. We will make any necessary adjustments to these lessons to accommodate the temporary changes, ensuring they can still fully engage in the sport.

This arrangement is temporary, and we expect the changing rooms to be fully available again at the start of next term. In the meantime, we ask that students still adhere to the school's PE kit requirements, ensuring they are wearing the appropriate PE kit as indicated in our uniform policy.

As we move into the autumn, students wearing PE kit for the whole day may wish to consider wearing their blazer or a school jumper outside of PE lessons, other non-uniform items will not be permitted.
