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

## Year 8 Assessment Week (school week 2) Tuesday 22<sup>nd</sup> – Friday 25<sup>th</sup> April 2025

I write to inform you that all Year 8 students will be sitting assessments (in classrooms) during the week detailed above. A copy of the examination timetable is found on the back of this page.

This is an opportunity for staff to assess students' progress after two terms of work in Year 8. It will provide information to go alongside ongoing assessment material gathered throughout the year when staff write end of year reports for each student. I am sure there is little need for me to stress the importance of these assessments as they will give students, parents and teachers a clear indication of the progress being made in each subject. Equally, I am certain you will support the school in stressing to your son or daughter the importance of thorough preparation for these assessments.

Teaching staff will inform students of the assessment requirements and areas of study being assessed in each subject in readiness for the tests – details will be provided on ClassCharts/ Teams. Please note that the Design Department, covering Art and the Technology subjects, is taught on a carousel basis which makes carrying out a 'single point in time' assessment impractical. To that end, students undertake regular end of project assessments in all of the Design disciplines as part of the teaching rotation over the course of the school year, hence these subjects do not appear on the attached timetable.

Some exams don't fit into the week due to the Bank Holiday and also because we don't want to go beyond three tests per day – please see the notes at the bottom of the table.
